## Statement on the Planned Execution of Kenneth Smith by the State of Alabama

This week the State of Alabama will use the most cruel, inhuman way to murder someone in history to murder Kenneth Smith, Nitrogen Hypoxia.

Kay Ivey, the supposed Pro-Life Christian governor of Alabama, signed the warrant to murder Smith with this fact in mind. Our own Father Jeff Hood will be by Smith's side as the state executes him on Thursday. Fr. Hood's bishop, The Right Rev. James St George, OSFoc, will be flying down to Alabama tomorrow morning to give Fr. Hood the Rite of Anointing in case the untested and dangerous precautions set up fail and Fr.
